In June, Coleman recalled approximately 229,000 units of the Coleman Converta Cot and Coleman Converta Camping Suspension Stretcher in the U.S. and Canada due to a pinch point issue posing laceration and amputation hazards. In September, Newell announced a recall of approximately 1.3 million units of the Oster French Door Countertop Ovens in the U.S. and Canada. Newell determined that the doors could unexpectedly close and pose a burn hazard to users, and a repair kit was offered to address the hazard.
